

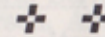

## WELCOME

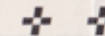

"Have I done my daily task?

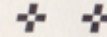
Have I kept my honor bright?

## THE EAGLE SCOUT TRAIL

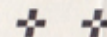


The Eagle Scout, whose notable achievement

With Scout Good Turns and slogan, "Be Prepared."

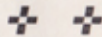
Then Second Class and First, with outdoor life,

Is ready to defend our way of life.

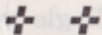
